

The event will take place in Montagu over the weekend of 8 and 9 November 2024, with the actual climbing and hiking day being on Saturday 9th.

Saturday the 9th at 6am, all participants and supporters must congregate at De Bos Guest Farm in Montagu to be briefed on the structure of the event.

Saturday morning, hikers will set off on one of the hiking trails around town and teams of climbers (2 in a team) will go to one of the many rock crags in the Montagu area, armed with a climbing score sheet, and climb as many rock climbs as possible to raise funds for these very worthy causes.

Typically a relatively competent team can climb 15 to 20 routes in a day. And a strong hiker can walk between 15 and 20 km in a day

16:30 PM will be cut-off time and all climbers and hikers must return to De Bos Guest Farm and hand in their score sheets.

The evening will revolve around a braai and general social gathering, during which there will be speeches from the organisers and sponsors, and there will also be a prize giving ceremony, where people will receive prizes for various achievements during the day. And some spot prizes!

And of course at the end of the evening we will hand over a "cheque" for funds raised to a representative of DKMS, Eseltjiesrus Donkey Sanctuary and AML.



Our organisation is dedicated to the fight against blood cancer and blood disorders. We create awareness, recruit blood stem cell donors to provide people with a second chance at life, raise funds to cover donor registration costs, and support the improvement of blood cancer therapies through our own research.

We also support patients from day one of their diagnosis, providing family and friends with a positive way to get involved by organising stem cell donor drives that can enhance your donor search, rally community support and provide hope.

What we do

- Education of the communities about caring for their animals.
- · Assistance with primary health care in the very poor communities.
- Sterilisation of pets in the very poor communities.
- Monitoring of and offering assistance to small scale farmers.

Animals Matter Langeberg is a volunteer run organisation that is based in the Langeberg area covering Montagu, Ashton, Bonnievale and Robertson, We started in February 2019 and are still growing, although we have already made a significant impact.

This is all done by a few volunteers and in the poor communities who walk from home to home to identify animals which need help. In this way we find animals that would otherwise never receive proper care. At this stage we cannot pick up stray animals as we do not have a property with holding kennels where they can be cared for. For this reason we also cannot do any re-homing of pets, so please contact the SPCA if you have a problem with a stray or lost animal.

We have successfully assisted with a feral cat 'trap-sterilise-release' program, and these cats are all being fed and cared for but can no longer produce more litters of kittens. If you are aware of feral cat problems you are welcome to contact us although we cannot promise to assist as

we already have a very busy program. Although we currently have no paid staff there are still plenty of costs involved - we are now operating at a clinical facility in Ashton where we do sterilisation surgeries and other minor procedures which are necessary, such as treating wounds. The drugs needed for the surgeries and also the medicines we need for the primary healthcare are a big expense.

We have to heavily subsidise pet owners as the owners that we assist are at the bottom end of the huge wealth disparity which we see here in South Africa. We have had a great deal of success raising funds so far thanks to the generosity of many - thank you to everyone who has supported us financially or in other ways.
